Spirit Chair & Spirit Committee: Do you love planning fun events? The Spirit Chair will lead various social events like Falcon Fest, Glow Party and Makers Fair. The Spirit Committee will support creating and executing the events. This is a fun and rewarding position. Hours fluctuate throughout the year. (2-4 hrs a week)

Community Builder: This person works to create community in our school and leads the PTA membership drive in the fall. (1-2 hrs a week)

Communications Chair: Do you have basic tech skills where you can help with the website, build a monthly calendar & organize communication to the Falcon Flyer? (1 hr a week)

**Legislature and Advocacy Chair:** 

Stay up to date on the happenings in the legislature and update the PTA. Encourage the FPE Community to speak to our representative on important issues & bills that impact the students. (1 hr a week, timing fluctuates throughout the year)

Adult & Parent Education: Are you passionate about educating adults on various parenting issues? Work to bring speakers or educational films to the FPE community. This role often collaborates with South Seattle Co-Op Preschools (1 hr a week, timing fluctuates throughout the year)

**Cohort Coordinator:** Organize the grade level cohort chairs (1 hr a week)

Cohort/Grade level Chair: Organize a few fun events throughout the year for a specific cohort/grade. (1-2 hrs a week)

Teacher Appreciation Week: Lead a committee to plan and execute the teacher appreciation week (20 hrs in April/May leading up to the event)
