Film Screening: Families Embracing Anti-Bias Values

SSC Co-op Preschools and Pathfinder K-8 are hosting a special screening of the new film. Families Embracing Anti-Bias Values, as well as a Q&A with producer Debbie LeeKeenan. The screening will take place on Thursday, October 24, 6:30-8:00 p.m. at Olympic Hall on the South Seattle College campus. This film, produced by Debbie LeeKeenan and John Nimmo, is a 50-minute documentary about families who intentionally parent with an anti-bias lens. Debbie and John partnered with filmmaker Filiz Efe McKinney of Brave Sprout Productions to create a film that raises up the voices of multiple families with diverse identities, talking about their hopes, fears, strengths, challenges, and questions as they figure out: What kind of world do we want to create with our children?
