# Winter 2025 PTA Enrichment Has Launched!

A few reminders for parents on safety and ensuring enrichment continues:

 Parent authorized dismissal: We need to connect with you first. Call out your name and your child's name for pickup. Please be physically in front of the school (not sitting in your car) at least for the first two weeks. If you have more than one person doing pickup, they need to be listed in homeroom. This is for safety until instructors know you and your child.

 Make sure your child understands expectations in after-school enrichment: 1) We listen to the instructors; 2) we only eat snacks outside of the classroom and we don't share: 3) we respect our borrowed space (leave all classroom items alone) so we are invited back to this space again and again.
