 - Wednesday Ultimate/FF (gr 2-5) and Friday Soccer (gr K-2): Meet at the baseball dugout nearest the play structure, next to the school blacktop.
 - Thursday Parkour (gr K-3): Meet in the Front Entrance Atrium (which is already the backup rain location).

- Vice President: Leadership role that supports the PTA president and steps in to help out in any areas that might need more support with the different committees.
- Treasurer: Manages the finances of the non-profit. Experience needed in finance, managing budgets, Paypal and Square.

- School Supplies: Bulk order the school supplies and organize the delivery to the school. (10 hrs in the summer)
